Lenten Study

Join Pastor Scott on the Journey of Lent Ash Wednesday (March 2) through Holy Week (April 15) using the devotional: Living into Lent. The Lenten journey is a shared journey. Living into Lent, written by noted Presbyterian theologian, educator, and author Donald K. McKim, sets aside time each day during the Lenten season for readers to reflect on their Christian identities, listen to God's Word and will, and engage in practices that deepen the Christian experience through discipleship.

Pastor Scott will lead a 45-minute discussion session based on the devotional readings from Living into Lent. There will be two opportunities to join the discussion each week during Lent: Sundays at 11:15am (in lieu of the pastor's Bible Study) and Thursdays at 6:30pm (via Zoom).

The book is \$13 and currently available in the Narthex. You can also find it on Kindle. We hope you can join us on this journey!

Worship Updates per Session

Due to the sharply falling rate of Covid infections and hospitalizations, effective March 6:

- Coffee fellowship will be reinstated in Fellowship Hall; masks will be required unless eating or drinking while seated;
- Worship leaders in the chancel area will be allowed to remove masks at their discretion while speaking;
- Tape will be removed from the pews in the front section of the church but remain in the back section; social distancing will be encouraged.
- Small groups may meet again at the church. Masks and social distancing are still required. If all participants of a group are vaccinated & boosted, then masks are optional (but encouraged.)
