# A Note From Mary Lathrop


I recently discovered that the PCUSA Giving Catalog desperately needs funds to combat worldwide hunger, aggravated by unemployment. People need food to both survive and combat disease. Examples of need are buying goats (\$178/ pair) for vitamin rich milk, and chickens for nutritious eggs (\$25 per family of 4). Longer help is needed for water wells or gran banks. These serve a community for many years (\$1500 ea., \$50/share). Imagine, for\$1500, a whole community could have a water for drinking, bathing, and irrigation just because of you!
