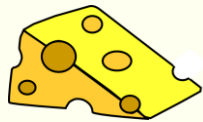

August Cheese Donation for Madison West High Area Collaborative (at Westminster)

This month we will purchase cheese from Widmer Cheese Cellars in Theresa, Wisconsin. Widmer's Cheese began over 98 years ago, when their founder, John O. Widmer, left Switzerland to come to America and he settled in Dodge County, Wisconsin. His grandson, Joe Widmer, carries on the tradition and is now the Master Cheese Maker. They are known for their authenticity, handcrafted quality and consistency. Widmer's Cheese Cellars are recognized for their Wisconsin Colby, aged Cheddar and classic Wisconsin Aged Brick.

They have generously offered us the chance to purchase cheese at a special price for both personal use and for donation to the Madison West High Area Food Collaborative, which distributes food to over 500 local families. This is a great way to support local families and local farmers!

NOTE: ALL orders are due by August 1st and cheese will be at the church by early the following week.

To buy cheese to donate to the Food Collaborative:

You can send checks directly to the church or Sandy Curran. For donations—to make checks out to Westminster and put "Cheese donation" in the memo line. You do NOT need to identify what cheese to give. Sandy will add up all the monetary gifts and purchase the most cheese possible for donation.

To buy cheese for yourself:

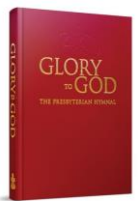

As online worship continues at Westminster, we are pleased to announce the “Hymnal at Home” program. If you do not currently have a copy of “Glory to God,” our denominational hymnal, you may:

- 1. Borrow one** from the church. Contact the church office to request to borrow a hymnal for your home use during the COVID-19 pandemic. Arrangements may be made for you to either pick up the hymnal from the church office or have someone follow all applicable safety guidelines to deliver a hymnal to you. You will return the borrowed hymnal when the pandemic has ended.
- 2. Purchase one** by contacting the church office who can order it for you. The pew edition of the hymnal, used in the sanctuary, is \$20.00. The large-print edition is \$30.00. An anonymous donor has agreed to cover the costs of shipping. You may make your checks payable to Westminster.

You may request to borrow a hymnal at any time but if you would like to order one for purchase, please let us know **before August 14**.
