### Summer Sermon Series - Daring Prayer: The Meaning of the Lord's Prayer for Today

Pastor Scott continues his 7-week summer sermon series focused on the meaning of the Lord's Prayer for today. Jesus taught his disciples what is now the best-known prayer in Christianity as a result of a request from his disciples, "Lord, Teach us to pray." Prayer is one of the most basic and potentially most transformative spiritual practices of our faith. This series will examine the Lord's Prayer line by line as we seek to understand the life of prayer for Christians. How does God answer prayer? How do we Presbyterians understand prayer? If we are reluctant pray-ers, can the Lord's prayer teach how to pray? We'll consider these and many other questions about the life of prayer.
